347	<u>Premises License Application</u> -	
347.1	Application to increase the area within which alcohol may be sold to include the main store and to extend the hours for sale of alcohol on Saturdays to 7am to 9pm (currently 8am to 9pm) at Mole Avon, Okehampton. Cllr Yelland declared an interest and the Committee noted that the premises fell within the Hamlets rather than the Town. RESOLVED on the proposition of Cllr Rush, seconded Cllr Ireland (1 abstention), to: i) OBJECT to the increase to the area within which alcohol may be sold to	

- include the main store on the grounds that the store does not currently sell food and drink;
- ii) NO OBJECTION to the extension of the hours for the sale of alcohol on Saturdays in the petrol station by 1 hour from 7am to 9pm
