Mobile Phone - To consider the purchase of a mobile phone for use of office staff
A mobile number is often required for deliveries, in addition some websites do not recognise the council's 'short' phone number and a mobile number is required to be added in its place.

A mobile is also required for events, for example the Coronation, when a number needs to be given to various contactors and/or volunteers; examples of these are marshals and first aid.

Various business contracts are available but the most suitable appears to be EE's mall Business Pay as You Use plan:

- No need to top-up or prepay as monthly calls are billed in arrears, by direct debit
- Only pay for calls and texts that are used each month
- Minimum 1 year contract
- Data is purchased separately: 30 days 1 GB is $£ 7.60$

30 days 250MB is $£ 2.84$
reoccurring monthly 1 GB is $£ 4.74$
reoccurring monthly 250 BM is not available

- Monthly subscription charge of $£ 1.25$ +VAT

The Committee is requested to consider:

- Approval of a 1 year contract with EE at the cost of $£ 1.25 \mathrm{p} / \mathrm{m}$ plus any call or text charges to be paid by direct debit
- The additional purchase of 250 MB of data as necessary
- The purchase of a second-hand mobile phone up to the value of $£ 120$
