229	<u>Members Questions</u> – Cllr Ireland requested an update with regards to parking issues he had raised at the previous meeting. 233	<u>Diversion of Footpath No 7 (HIW PROW 18 040)</u> – On the proposition of Cllr Rush, seconded by Cllr Yelland (2 abstentions), it was RESOLVED to agree the proposition to divert the footpath Cllr Leech requested an item be included on the next agenda regarding Town Council asset boundaries. 234	<u>Crediton Road, Redrow Development Phase 2</u> – Cllr Yelland declared a personal interest in this item being a member of WDBC.	

An informal meeting with the developers and Members of Okehampton Hamlets Parish Council had been attended by Cllrs Cushing, Rush and the Clerk.

Archaeology work had commenced and Councillors would be invited to view any findings and the site in due course. It was anticipated that the Phase 1 show area would be open in October 2018, with occupation commencing in early 2019. A TPO had been served on a large Oak tree within the development.

The planning application for Phase 2 was anticipated to be submitted by October 2018, housing would be of the same mix of materials as in Phase 1, although possibly with a higher percentage of brick.
