457	<u>Declarations of Interest</u> – None	
458	<u>Apologies for Absence</u> – Apologies for absence were received on behalf of Cllrs Parkins, Marsh, Carpenter and Tolley	
459	<u>Deferments of Business</u> – The member of public spoke about the JLP modification consultations and his views which included that development of brownfield sites should be prioritised over greenfield sites, and that the building of 775 homes already in progress in Okehampton and approximately another 150 in the surrounding area, which would likely be going through the planning process prior to the adoption of the JLP, should be sufficient in number for the area. Plymouth had previously agreed that they would take up any shortfall in numbers which should help to alleviate the need for more in Okehampton.	
460	<u>Members Questions</u> – Cllr Ireland requested updates regarding the previously reported issue of blocks removed from a courtesy crossing and a vehicle. Cllr Leech advised that there was no update on the blocks and that as the vehicle was parked on private land nothing could be done about it.
