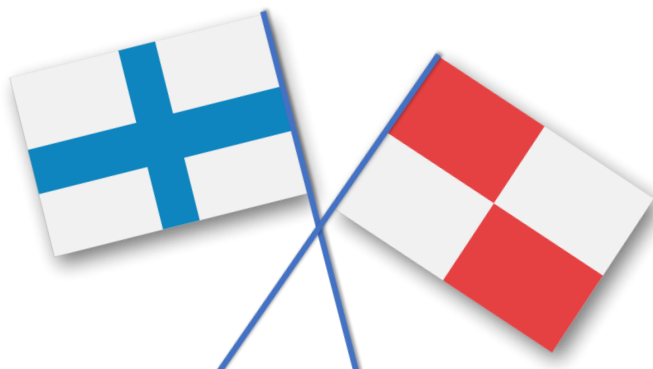


# Adventures ALONG THE Trafalgar Way

There'll be flags to wave and the chance to sit inside some of the cars as they pull in to complete their compulsory pitstops, so please come along & join in—and remember to bring your camera!

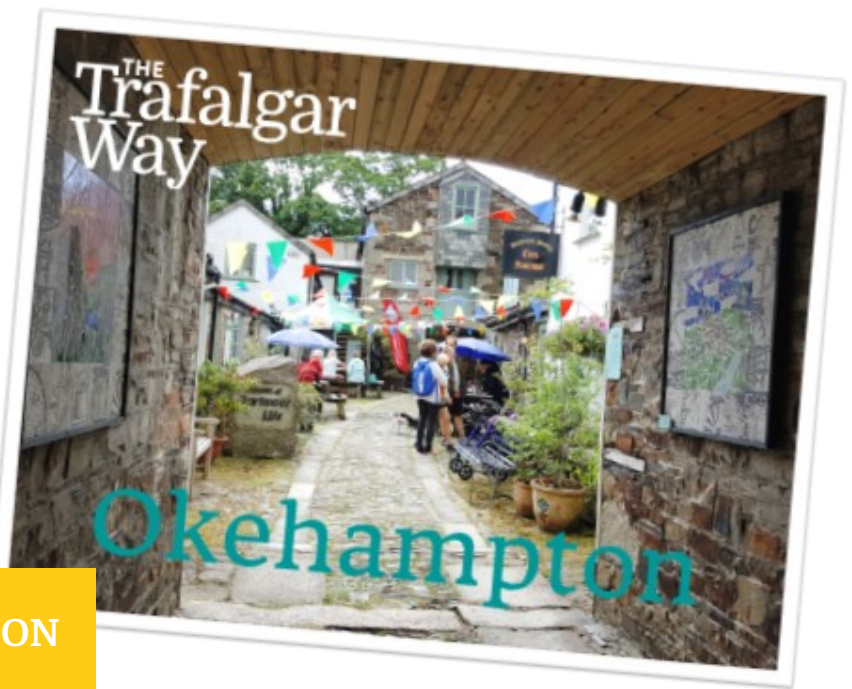
On May 19th cars will continue to **FALMOUTH** and on to Cape Cornwall.
