- 771 Apologies for Absence** – Apologies received from Cllr Tucker, who was away to attend a funeral, was **APPROVED** on the proposition of Cllr Leech, seconded Cllr Sanger.
- 772 Urgent Items** – The Clerk reported on latest advice relating to the COVID-19 (Coronavirus) Pandemic advising that the Emergency Committee had met to make arrangements in the event that the offices had to close to ensure the continuation of council services.
