- 8. <u>Vehicles in Simmons Park</u> To note that a van, has been regularly parked just inside the main pedestrian entrance gates whilst conversion work is being undertaken and that the owner has been advised that this is not permitted, and an alternative location should be found.
- 9. <u>Simmons Park and Fairplace Leaflet</u> To resolve to approve the final draft leaflet and printing the printing of 300 copies by a local company who use environmentally friendly products, vegetable-based ink, and recycled paper, at a cost of £126.
- **10.** <u>Fairplace Sensory Garden</u> To note that the work is almost complete and that a s.106 funding contribution has been awarded by WDBC in the sum of £1,565 forwards the costs.
- Fairplace Proposal (St James Street) To consider a proposal by Cllr Leech for a statue in the centre of the newly created sensory garden at Fairplace and replacement of the metal fencing

- <u>Tree Work, Simmons Park</u> To resolve to approve a request from Hi-Line to undertake tree/ vegetation management work in Simmons Park to maintain safety clearances from the power cables.
