434	<p><u>Land for Sale, Okehampton</u> – Cllrs Marsh and Ireland declared personal interests being members of Okehampton United Charities (OUC).</p> <p>The Clerk read a statement from the OUC advising that they were submitting a tender for all the plots of land that were for sale at Kempley’s Barn, Okehampton and at Ball Hill/Tramlines.
