

<u>Anchor Bolt Request</u> – To consider correspondence received from WDBC in relation to the request from Everything Okehampton for permission to renew the anchor bolts on the front elevation of the Town Hall enabling the provision of new tension cables to support the Christmas lights

The following has been received from WDBC about the need for planning permission:

As I said it is up to the Town Council to either: 1) Assess the works and conclude LBC is not needed as character and special interest are unaffected. 2) Think there is no harm but seek written confirmation that LBC is not needed via a Certificate of Lawfulness for Proposed Works to a Listed Building. 3) Apply for LBC.
