**899**     **Premises Licence Application**

**Application for a new premises licence form Murat Sengun at Tony’s Grill, School Way, Okehampton EX20 1EU:** For the provision of late-night refreshments Saturday 23:00 to 03:30. The opening hours for this premises are: 17:00-23:00 Sunday to Friday and 17:00-03:30 on a Saturday night. A late-night refreshment is only licensable between 23:00-05:00.

It was commented that it was unclear if the application was for permission to sell food or alcohol.

On the proposition of Cllr Goffey, seconded Cllr Tolley, it was **RESOLVED** to OBJECT to the application if it was for the sale of alcohol, but to support if it was purely for the sale of food. The objection for the sale of alcohol was on the following grounds:

- Prevention of crime and disorder
- Prevention of public nuisance
- Public safety
- Protection of children from harm
