New Simmons Park Information Boards and Pedestrian Signs

New information boards have been provided in the park. They contain a newly designed map of the park showing footpaths and walking routes as well as facilities and amenities. One of the signs is by the carpark near the book swap and the other by the pedestrian entrance. In addition, two smaller maps will be provided at the top footpath entrances into the park from Station Road. The smaller maps show the walking routes between the station and the town centre as well as containing a QR code to download the Everything Okehampton App.

These signs accompany new fingerposts provided by the Council in conjunction with others including GWR who awarded some grant funding towards the project. DCC Highways have kindly helped by putting up the new fingerpost signs which will help visitors navigate around Okehampton as well as to and from the Railway Station where another map has been provided as part of the scheme.
