## Okehampton Celebrates the 400<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Town Charter – 9<sup>th</sup> July

A massive thank you to everyone involved in arranging this event. There are too many to name individually, but particular thanks go to Everything Okehampton who arranged the overall event and OCRA who provided lots of sporting entertainment and served over 400 free cream teas from the Marquee.





The Anniversary cakes celebrating 400 years of the Town Charter, 150 years of Okehampton United Charity and 125 years of Okehampton Hamlets Parish Council were cut at 2pm by the Town Mayor, Clerk to Trustees and Chairman of the Hamlets Parish Council. Most importantly, a big thank you to all of you who came along to

support this event. It was lovely to see so many people enjoying themselves in the sun, which shone most of the time, taking part in the activities, supporting the businesses and organisations, and watching the live performances.



The 400-year timeline, an extract of which can be seen below, that was displayed in the Marquee was put together by a number of organisations including The Museum of Dartmoor Life, Okehampton United Charity, Okehampton Hamlets Parish Council and



Okehampton Town Council. This 24-metre-long piece of history, commissioned by the Town Council, will eventually be on display in the Charter Hall for all to see. Limited edition pull-out versions, an extract of which can be seen below, can be purchased for £5 from the Town Hall or Everything Okehampton who have them available for sale and to whom the proceeds from will go.

### Simmons Park Bandstand Refurbishment Project



A bequest to the Town Council from the late Mr John Pestridge has partly funded the project and will be acknowledged by the addition of a plaque in the next few weeks. Also to be added are plaques

The old bandstand base adjacent to Chalet Treloar in Simmons Park has been reinstated with a 'top' as the main part of an enhancement project. It is envisaged this could form the backdrop for exhibitions, wedding photographs or other events in the park. To the left is a photo of the original bandstand in this location taken in 1912.

Planting around the base is due to be refurbished with bulbs, flowers and shrubs fitting to the memory of the late Queen Elizabeth II and favourites of the Royal Family courtesy of Lottery funding received towards the Coronation celebrations earlier in the year and for associated planting.

#### Did you know that hedgehogs travel up to 2 miles each night to forage for food and meet mates?

So, what can we do to help them make their way safely through our communities avoiding roads where possible? We can make small gaps in our hedges and fences, linking areas together so that they can move around more easilv.

Okehampton Town Council is supportive of the Hedgehog Highway Project which aims to highlight their importance and declining numbers and has a few 'highway surrounds' available to purchase from the Town Hall at the cost price of £3.
