- Charter Hall Roofing Project (Cllrs Ireland and Tolley arrived)
 The Clerk reported the cost of insuring the project would be in the region of £800 and the council's insurer would not provide cover for related water ingress. On the proposition of Cllr Colman, seconded Cllr Leech it was RESOLVED to accept and approve the insurance policy and the resulting cost.

A voice message left on the Clerk's mobile from the Project Manager on 8th November with information relating to the contract pertaining to potential cost increases of steel, flat roofing materials and decorating work was heard and considered by Cllrs. Cllr Leech advised slate costs were due to increase by 10% from 1 January, the cost of which had been saved due to their prior purchase.

Once clarification had been received the Clerk was to advise Councillors of the outcome and was delegated authority to accept the contract cost providing it did not exceed that stated.
