T002 Rowan – Fell to ground level due to being in decline and entering services causing damage/disruption. T003: Rowan – Fell tree to ground level due to being dead.
T001: - Norway Maple – Fell tree to ground level, justification the base of the tree has occluded a wooden post successfully, this tree is directly above main lateral sewer drain which is also considered to have root ingress and have severe defects, this tree is also directly above drainage services and is more than likely causing root ingress within drainage system.
