### Remembrance Parade and Service

At 11am on Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> November an act of Remembrance is being held alongside the Memorial at All Saints Church followed by an indoor service. There will be a procession from Fore Street to the Church, followed by a return march to the town centre. In order to facilitate this, there will be a rolling road closure in place for a short period of time.



## FINANCE OFFICER

Okehampton Town Council are looking to recruit a Finance Officer, to start as soon as possible.

- Hours 22.5 p/week. Monday to Wednesday 9am to 5pm (or as agreed by the Town Clerk but must include Mondays). Occasional evening and weekend work may be required.

This is an office-based role in a busy environment. You will need to have demonstrable financial management experience, including the processing of VAT returns, working knowledge of Rialtas Omega financial, or similar, software and the processing of salaries and pensions.

Ideally you will have knowledge of local council procedures and regulations, and you must be prepared to undertake training, including achievement of the Financial Introduction to Local Council Administration (FILCA) qualification.

Enhanced DBS checks will be undertaken in accordance with requirements for the running of Okehampton Youth Council.

**Town Centre Business Grant Initiative** - At the beginning of the financial year, the council put aside unspent funds amounting to £2,896 from the 2023/24 Grant budget to be used this year for a pilot scheme – a Town Centre Business Grant Initiative. This grant will enable businesses to apply for funding to spruce up their shop fronts which will improve the overall look of the town centre.

WDBC have added to this grant pot by providing double the funds, increasing the amount available within the budget to £8,688.

## Notice of Co-option of Councillor

The Returning Officer at the office of West Devon Borough Council has confirmed that the Council can now fill the casual vacancy for the North Ward by co-option.

NOTICE is hereby given that pursuant to Rule 8 of the Local Elections (Parishes and Communities) Rule 1986 the council will fill the casual vacancy by co-option.

The council may co-opt any person who is legally qualified to hold such office, and who is willing to serve provided they meet the criteria as set out in the Local Government Act 1972 and are not for any reason disqualified – please contact the Town Clerk for further details.

Provided the person also satisfies at least ONE of the following they may apply:

- They are registered as a local government elector for the parish
- They have during the whole of the preceding twelve months occupied as owner or tenant, any land or premises in the parish
- Their principal or only place of work during the preceding twelve months has been in the parish
- They have during the whole of the preceding twelve months resided in the parish or within 4.8 km of it

They must also be 18 years or older on the day they become nominated for election.

Applicants are to contact the Town Council, details below, for information and the application form which can be downloaded from the website.

The casual vacancy will be filled by co-option at a meeting of the Council at 7pm on Monday 16th December 2024.

Closing date for applications is 12noon Friday 6th December 2024.
