To have authority to authorise cheque and BACS payments for all invoices and expenses relevant to the business of the council

Sale of Alcohol, Charter Hall

To act as the Charter Hall Management Committee in relation to the sale of alcohol in the premises during events. The Chairman of the Property Committee and Town Clerk, having delegated authority to approve requests.
