In early February the Youth Council set

A first aid course for children aged 7+ was hosted by the Youth Council in the Charter Hall during half term. The course was funded by a grant from Cllr Lois Samuel, DCC, meaning

that it was able to be offered to local children free of charge.

### **Town Council Grants 2025-26**

Okehampton Town Council has agreed a budget of £29,000 for the award of grants supporting community organisations and groups to the benefit of the residents of Okehampton in the 2025/26 financial year.

Applications will be considered in the spring and autumn. Those for consideration in the spring must be received by Friday 25th April 2025 and in the autumn by 29th August 2025. The grant policy and application form can be downloaded from the council website or obtained from the Town Hall.

### BMX/Pump Track Improvement (Tender opportunity)

The Skatepark Complex, incorporating the BMX track and skatepark, is in need of improvement but due to the size of the project the work is being phased. Phase 1 is the upgrading of the existing BMX track.

The Council has commenced the process for a design and build tender for a BMX/MTB/Skate Asphalt surfaced pump track on the footprint of the existing BMX track off of North Road which is approximately 300m in length. The track needs to cater for all abilities, whilst challenging experienced riders and being safe for beginners as well as being suitable for use for scooters and skateboards.


