

4th December. Further information about this to follow.


Please be advised there will be a short time when the relevant roads will be closed for both the Civic and Remembrance Parades and Services to allow the procession to safely get to and from the Church.



Town Council Grants

In July the Policy & Resources Committee awarded the following grants to not-forprofit groups and organisations. The next review will take place on 3rd November.

- DYS Space (Room 13) £300 towards purchase of items to refurbish the garden area
- Hospiscare £800 towards funding for an Admiral Nurse
- Museum of Dartmoor Life £3,500 towards running and maintenance costs
- Ockment Centre £4,000 towards staffing costs of the facility
- Okehampton Armed Forces Veterans Breakfast Club £300 towards the cost of advertising materials
- Okehampton District Transport Group £1,500 towards the cost of continuation of the transport service
- Okehampton Fairtrade Group £90 for room hire refreshments and speaker fee
- Okehampton Hamlets Parish Council £200 towards refreshments costs of Beating the Bounds in 2025
- Tor Support Services £5,000 to fund approximately 94 counselling sessions
- St James' Chapel £1,000 towards the upkeep of the Town Clock and Chapel


