

Allotments - On 29th September 2026 the Town Councill will be taking over responsibility for the three allotment sites from Okehampton United Charities. The sites will remain in use as allotments.

Hire Fees and Charges for the Charter Hall and other facilities have been reviewed and are not increasing for 2026/27. The only change is to management of the Coffee Mornings which will be restricted to two events per year for each organisation, one of which can be in the Christmas period (November/December).
