Works to trees in a conservation area at Okehampton Community College, Mill Road, Okehampton, EX20 1PW, details below:

T1: horse chestnut - fell, excessive dieback, replant with beech or similar native spp; G1: Lime, Beech, Horse chestnut – raise canopy droop to 6 metres over driveway to remove vehicle damage; G2: lime, beech, horse chestnut mix - remove deadwood as required for public safety (Exempt); T2: oak - fell, excessive shading, proximity to buildings, high target value, chemical store adjacent to tree, outgrown surroundings, replant with one oak or similar native spp; T3: oak - crown reduction to reduce weight and create 1.5 metres clearance from building; T4: turkey oak - fell, squirrel damage, dropped x3 branches over footpath, replant with x1 English oak; T5: Ash - Fell, crown dieback, replant with x1 native spp.
